

Uno (Ocho) Rules

Rules

- 1. Schedule the time and day of all of your own matches with your opponents before the play-by date
- 2. For Rec leagues, team names must include captain's gamer tag with team name in parentheses. For College leagues, team names must include captain's name and the college they represent (Example: Cara Caspersen- Brown).
- 3. Keep a record of the time/date of the match, and scores for each INDIVIDUAL game (ex: 21-7)
- 4. Play your opponent! If you signed-up, you are expected to play your match!
- 5. Scoring: A match will consist of the best 2 out of 3 games.
- 6. Scoring in Playoffs: A match will consist of the best 3 out of 5 games.
- 7. Games are won by the first person running out of cards.
- 8. Players must have the Plato App on their device to participate in the Esports: Uno league. The app is free to download and play.
- 9. The winner must submit scores to the IMS Website ASAP after each match at https://recreation.rice.edu/ims/reportscores.

Collège League

The league will be split into multiple divisions and an attempt to spread out as many people as possible between divisions so they are not having to play members from their college. However in some cases, this may not be possible. We will then take the top 3 finishers per college to the playoffs and those three will represent their college together as a team (i.e. regular season as individuals, playoffs as a team of 3). This means each round of the playoffs will be a best of 5 games and the 3 participants from each college will need to decide who will play for their college in each game until the first team collects 3 wins. Teams cannot have an individual play in more than 2 of the games in the best of 5 series. If a college does not have 3 people to represent them, then only that one or two people for that college will represent them in the playoffs.




How-To-Play

1. Download Plato App




2. On Home Screen you select the Friends tab to either add a new friend by Plato ID (IMleagues username) or select a current friend to play.



3. Now you will need to select the bottom left tab with the games piece symbol. This will allow you to choose Uno also known as Ocho in this app.





4. After choosing your Uno, you will be prompted to select your game details. Choose:


a. Game: Ocho
